

Our board at Cathedral Bluffs Yacht Club has agreed to accept boating visitors only from reciprocating clubs, commencing Monday, July 20th, subject to the following:

- We will be able to place visitors only on the main dock, thereby limiting visiting boats to a maximum of 4.
- All visiting boats must reserve space at least 2 days in advance by emailing Nick Lawley (Fleet Captain) at fleetcaptain@cbyc.ca.
- Once accepted by the Fleet Captain, the visiting boat will be emailed a package and a covid 19 statement of health and disclaimer which must returned signed before reservation can be confirmed.
- Whether a boat is visiting for a night or an hour, the same requirements will apply.
- All visits will be for one night only.
- At this point, in part due to limited capacity, visitors will be able to utilize only the restaurant takeout facilities.
- The clubhouse is closed to visitors, except for washroom facilities.
- As per legal requirements, masks must be worn in all indoor facilities including the washrooms, and are strongly recommended throughout the club. Two meter distancing is also required.
- Visiting boats may use only the visitors outdoor pavilion and BBQ.
- Visitors on any one boat must be from the same "family bubble".
